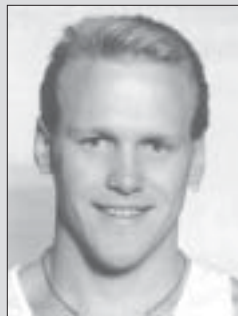

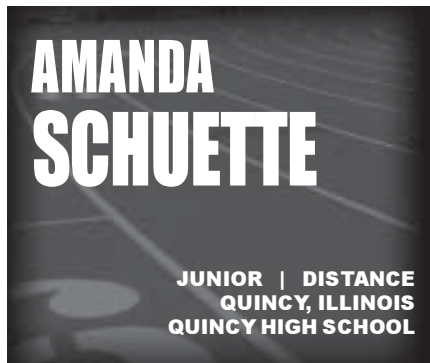

**E**astern Illinois Panther athletics has dominated the Ohio Valley Conference All-Sports Championship since joining the league back in 1996.

For the third straight year and fourth time in seven years, Eastern was the combined All-Sports Champions for 2002-03. The men were first and the women were third in their respective divisions. It's also the third straight year the men have finished first in their division.

Last year, Eastern won four regular-season conference championships in men's cross country, men's indoor and outdoor track, and co-champion in football advancing to the

NCAA I-AA playoffs. In addition, women's soccer won the OVC post season tournament for the second straight year to qualify for the NCAA tournament.

"The 2002-03 year was again extremely successful for Panther student-athletes and coaches. The past three seasons we've had 15 conference champions with seven teams advancing into NCAA tournament competition," said **Dr. Rich McDuffie**, Director of Athletics.

In the seven years that EIU has been a member of the OVC, the 'Cats' have won four combined All-Sports championships, finished second on two occasions, and third once.

The OVC is in its 56th year of existence as the nation's eighth oldest NCAA Division I conference. The OVC's proud history dates back to its inaugural season in 1948.

Three charter members, Eastern Kentucky, Murray State and Morehead State still are among the 11 league members. Other longtime members are Austin Peay, Tennessee State and Tennessee Tech. In 2003, Jacksonville State and Samford became the newest members joining Southeast Missouri (1991), Tennessee-Martin (1992) and Eastern Illinois (1996).
